Allaahumma-j'al fee qalbee noor-an, wa fee lisaanee noor-an, waj'al fee sam'ee noor-an,
waj'al fee basaree noor-an , waj'al min khalfee noor-an, wa min amaamee noor-an, waj'al
min fawqee noor-an, wa min tahtee noor-an, allahumma a'tinee noor-an

O Allah, place light in my heart, and light on my tongue, and light within my ears, and light in my eyes, and place behind me light and in front of me light and above me light and beneath me light, O Allah bestow on me light!

When entering the mosque

" أَعُوذُ بِاللَّهِ الْعَظِيمِ، وَبِوَجْهِهِ الْكَرِيمِ، وَسُلْطَانِهِ الْقَدِيمِ، مِنَ الشَّيْطَانِ الرَّجِيمِ ". [بِسْمِ
اللَّهِ، وَالصَّلَاةِ وَالسَّلَامِ عَلَى رَسُولِ اللَّهِ] " اللَّهُمَّ افْتَحْ لِي أَبْوَابَ رَحْمَتِكَ "

'A'oothu billaahil-'Adheem, wa bi-Wajhihil-Kareem, wa Sultaanihil-qadeem, minash-Shaytaanir-rajeem. [Bismillaahi, wassalaatu.] [Wassalaamu 'alaaRasoolillaahi.] Allaahum-maftah lee 'abwaaba rahmatika.

I seek refuge in Almighty Allah, by His Noble Face, by His primordial power, from Satan the outcast.1
[In the Name of Allah, and blessings.]2 [And peace be upon the Messenger of Allah.]3 O Allah, open
before me the doors of Your mercy.4

When leaving the mosque

" بِسْمِ اللّٰهِ، وَالصَّلَاةُ وَالسَّلَامُ عَلَى رَسُوْلِ اللّٰهِ، اللّٰهُمَّ اِنِّيْ اَسْأَلُكَ مِنْ فَضْلِكَ، اللّٰهُمَّ
اعصمني مِنَ الشَّيْطَانِ الرَّجِيْمِ "

Bismillaahi wassalaatu wassalaamu 'alaa Rasoolillaahi, Allaahumma 'innee 'as'aluka min fadhlika, Allaahumma'simnee minash-Shaytaanir-rajeem.

In the Name of Allah, and peace and blessings be upon the Messenger of Allah. O Allah, I ask for Your favor, O Allah, protect me from Satan the outcast.
